#### Eggy Characters

Make your own characters out of eggs. You could try do egg blowing too!



Stone Xs and Os

Create your own game of xs

and os using stones.

### Chalk Walk Photoshoot

Design a set for a photoshoot using chalk or else using things you find around your home.



#### Toilet Roll Printing

Design a stamper using toilet roll cores.





#### Feely Box

Make your own feely box and blindfold people to see can they work out what is inside.



#### Tie Dye T-Shirt

(gloves! Pre-soak in ½ water ½ vinegar) Half a cup of water 7 or 8 drops food colouring. Set in plastic wrap for 8 hours. Rinse



#### Giant Marble Maze

Make a giant maze with toilet roll cores. Change the challenge by going through different coloured tunnels in different orders.



#### Clapping Game

Learn a new clapping rhyme or create a secret handshake.



#### Butter in a Jar

Put a few marbles in a jar. Add in some cream. Shake and shake and shake and see what happens.



#### Bottle Toss

Use the top of an old bottle and make a tin foil ball. Attach together with a string (stick layer of tissue over tin foil with PVA glue) and try to score some points.

#### Magic Painting

Use a paintbrush and some water to do magic painting on footpath or patio.



#### Slime

PVA glue, formil from lidl (white cap), food colouring



#### Sensory Tray

Fill a baking tray with salt/sugar/lentils/shaving foam etc to fill a baking tray. Draw some pictures on your canvas.



#### Puppet Making

Make puppets and a puppet theatre using items from your home! Sock puppets are easy peazy!



#### Masking Tape Active Trail

Use tape to create a trail, jumping, balancing, hopping and doing pressups!



#### Floating and Sinking

Fill a basin or sink or bath with water and experiment to see what floats and sinks.



#### Pea Planting

Dry a pea/bean in the hot press and pop it into a jam jar with cotton wool.



#### **Band Jam**

Use pots and pans to create your own drum kit and rock on!



#### Instrument Making

Make a shaker with rice and a bottle or elastic band guitars!




#### Rising Snakes

Create your own game of bowling. You can add numbers for points!



**DIY Giant Bubbles** 

Use an old hanger/ string/ top of a plastic bottle to play with some fairy liquid and water bubble solution



Pasta Threading

Use some pasta and old string to make a snake/necklace or other creation.



Go through some old photos or find some information out about what you were like when you were little!



#### String Lazer Beam Game

Make a web by looping string to lots of different things and try get through without touching it!



#### T-Shirt Challenge

Can two people fit inside a tshirt? One arm can be used each. Try make a sandwich or other task.



#### Sock Flier

Fill a small bag with some rice/lentils etc and close. Place inside an old sock and tie closed with string or elastic band. Decorate and throw!



#### Play Shop

Design your own shop and label your items! Use real money or make your own toy money and play shop



#### Test Taste

Blindfold on! Can you work out what you are tasting? Try do a smell test too!



# Turn Your Food into a Family

Decorate the outside packaging or peels of fruit to create your food family!
Write a story to go with them, maybe they are scared you will eat them?



#### Sensory Walk

Find five things you can smell, see, taste (don't try it!), touch and hear!



#### Salt Dough

Make your own salt dough creations and get a grown up to help you cook them in the oven!



#### Quiz Night

Get the quizmaster to find some facts out about the family and see who knows what about others!



#### Heart Rate Experiment

Measure how many beats in 10 seconds, multiply by 6! Do exercise and see does it change.



#### Condensation Experiment (adult)

Watch the steam rise from the kettle, can you make your breathe condense on window? A new art canvas!




#### Restaurant Experience

Create a menu, set up your restaurant. Ring the doorbell and have the grownups serve you or the other way around!



**Egg Safety Container**Design a container to protect an egg. See can you drop it

#### Fridge Stock Take

Go to the fridge and time yourself to do a stock take! Younger children can copy labels



#### Nature Kitchen

Use items from nature to create a mini kitchen. Come up with your own mud pie recipes!



#### Rubbings

Use textured objects that are real or manmade. Put them under the sheet and use crayons to do some rubbings.



#### Sailboat Scientists

Design a floating sailboat, use your breath to blow it along.

Can you make a land sail machine with wheels?



#### Rainbow Ice Painting

Mix up some watery paint or food colouring and put into ice cube mould with a stick in each one. Freeze overnight.



#### JunkArt Town

Create a town using cardboard and pens and paper. Use some toys to play with your town.



#### Dizzy Ear Experiment


Do some spinning and see how it makes you feel. Put a spoon into a glass of water and swirl it around. What happens? Why?

Make a T.V. with some recycled cardboard and host your own T.V. show.



# Interview a Parent History Project

Interview a grown up to find out about what it was like when they were little.



#### Vinegar and Baking Soda

Create an experiment with baking soda and vinegar.

Maybe design a volcano or dragon on the outside of the bottle.



#### **Talent Show**

Have a family talent show and score each other.



#### Running Colours

Use some markers to colour on tissue. Add some water to watch the colours travel around the sheet.



#### Bottle Flip Challenge

Use your bottle to fill it with different amounts of water to see can you become a pro bottle flipper

#### Paper Chains

Cut scrap paper into long strips and see who can make the longest paper chain.



#### **Obstacle Course**

Use things in your home, you can go under, over, through to create an obstacle course.



#### Throwing Game

Set up a target (you could blutac paper numbers to the wall for points) and see can you score!



#### Sensory Tiles

Use different materials you find inside and outside to make a sensory walk challenge!



**Printing**Use potato or apple or cardboard to make stampers.



#### Ice Explorer

Freeze some small toys in bags or containers and see can you dig them out!

#### Potion Play

Ask an adult what you can use to set up your own potion lab! You could write some of the recipes too! Or Blindfold someone and get them to auess what is in it!



Ear Experiment

Blindfolded, get someone to make noise and try locate where it is coming from.



#### D.I.Y. Puppet Theatre

Use junk art materials to design your own puppet theatre. You can record a show on a phone and watch it back



#### Flower Press

Collect some flowers when you are walking.
Spread them on a piece of paper and pop paper on top. Press under heavy books.



#### Kitchen Roll Marble Pass

You need two kitchen rolls. Put the marble in kitchen roll number two. The second person will need to get it with their kitchen roll. How far can you travel?



# Make your own Chalk for the Path

Make your own paint and watch it dry!



#### Blindfold Sensory Box

Hide some items (spoons, pencils, toys) in a sesnory box and try guess what they are.



#### Wormery

Use an empty bottle (with small air holes) and layer with soil/sand/gravel. Top up with compost items to feed your worms.



#### Secret Message

Write secret messages on someone's back and see can they work out what it is.



#### Make your Own Board Game

Design your very own board game using paper and pens.



#### Sock Bubbles

Use fairy liquid and water to make bubble misture.
Cover bottle (end off) with a sock and blow into the



#### **Ball Toss**

Use tubs/boxes to create targets with differnet points and toss in.



#### Paper Clip Family

Design you own paper clip family. You can link them together either to make a chain.



#### D.I.Y. Stress Ball

Pour some of your filling inside a bottle. Inflate balloon, twist and place over top of bottle. Untwist and turn upside down, tie and design!



#### Tin Foil Craft

Stick string/PVA and tissue into a pattern on to card. Cover with tinfoil and allow it to dry!



#### Scrap Paper Mosiac

Use scraps of paper cut into squares to deisgn a mosaic. You could put certain colours in certain places to deisgn a picture.



#### Cardboard Nail Salon

Draw hands on some old card and have a mini pamper party!



#### Wooden Spoon Hunt

Hide treasure under an overturned plastic or wooden bowl. While blindfolded, tap the floor to see can you find the treasue. Hot and Cold helping hints!



#### Gloop

Cornflour and water. Messy fun so have the room prepped for with!



#### Stone Art

Paint some stones that you may have from a walk. You can do pebble art too!




#### Pillow Sack Race

Use an old pillow case to have a sack race.



#### Tin Can Telephone

Use two empty tin cans and string to make your own can telephone. A grown up needs to help with the hole!



#### Deep Sea Diver

Make a weighted diver, fill a bottle and close lid.
Squeeze in centre of bottle.



#### Jam Jar Snow Globe

Fill an old jar with some toys, glitter etc. Glue and allow to dry. Fill with water and some oil if you wish. Seal it tight with alue!



# Cardboard FacePainting

Draw a face on cardboard and facepaint your character into something new.



#### Ove Glove Pass the Parcel

Play pass the parcel. If it stops on you, you need to wear oven gloves while opening the parcel. Try some other tasks too!



# **Egg and Spoon**Have an egg and spoon race. Maybe have a mini sports



#### D.I.Y. Marble Maze

Try make your own marble maze, you could use straws to make a pathway either!



#### Colander Kerplunk

Use a colander and some spaghetti to make your own game of kerplunk.



#### Earn Your Keep

If you make the money sparkle you can keep it!
Coppers advisable!



#### Operation

Deisgn you own game of operation. Use a tweezers to pluck out peas/beans/coins etc.



#### Changing Face Characters

Design your own changing face monsters with a scroll of paper inside a toilet roll.



#### Tin Can Monster Feet

Use paper, tin cans and string to make your own monster feet.



#### Spaghetti or Pasta Construction

Use blutac/plasticine to join two pieces together.



#### Charades

Play a family game of charades.



#### Tiny Toy Parachute

Use a small toy, string and plastic bag to design your own parachute man.



#### Paper Race

Cut some shapes (ghosts or aliens!) out of newspaper or scrap paper. Colour in and place on hard floor. Have a blowing race to see how quikckly it can move.



#### Sock Soft Toy

Use an old sock and fill with rice/lentils/stuffing etc partly and tie with elastic or string. Repeat to form next shape. You can cut the fabric or fill more depending on what you are creating!



#### Blowing Football

Use cotton wool or win foil balls to make a mini ball.
Draw out your pitch. Use straws to blow and move the balls to try and score goals.



#### Wax Resist Painting

Use was crayon to draw a picture. Water down some paint and paint over the top.



#### Cups Target

Set up some target with cups and stick on numbers to create points for each target. See who can score the highest points.



#### Kinetic Sand

4 cups plain flour 1/2 cup baby oil



Three Legged Race

Use a tie or long socks to work in pairs to have a three legged race.



Sock Volley Ball

Use a pair of old socks to play volleyball.



#### Growing Hairy Monsters

Use seeds to make a monster that will continue to grow.



#### Play Parachute Games with a Duvet Cover or Sheet

Keep the ball up, knock it off, run under, make a dome by sitting under it, crocodile drags you under.
